

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

User Safety Requirements

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet and change into clean clothing

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to mammals, birds, and other wildlife. Bait exposed to soil surfaces may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Dogs, cats and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the high-water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate.

FIRST AID

Anticoagulant (Bis-hydroxycoumarin class)

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If Swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. ▪ Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. ▪ Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. ▪ Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If on Skin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Take off contaminated clothing. ▪ Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. ▪ Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If Inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Move person to fresh air ▪ If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. ▪ Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If in Eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. ▪ Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. If ingested, administer Vitamin K₁ intramuscularly or orally. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times.

TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING

If animal eats bait, call veterinarian at once.

NOTE TO VETERINARIAN

Anticoagulant Chlorophacinone: For animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (bleeding or elevated prothrombin times), give Vitamin K₁.

ARTICHOKES

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may only be used to control California Voles (*Microtus californicus*) in artichoke fields in California. Contact your County Agricultural Commissioner's office if you need help in determining whether California voles are damaging your artichokes.

Do not apply this product in or around homes or other human residences. **Do not** apply this bait anywhere but to bare ground in vole invested artichoke fields. **Do not** apply this product by any other method other than the method specified in this label.

Do not apply this product in occupied habitat of endangered species that may be harmed by exposure to this bait or to animals that have consumed it. Contact your County Agricultural Commissioner's office or <http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/es/colist.htm> for information on endangered species that use of this product in your area might impact.

Do not apply this product in any way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in area during application. Keep all other persons out of treatment area during application.

Do not apply bait when rain is likely within 24 hours. **Do not** apply on roads or in water or in areas accessible to farm or ranch animals.

Baiting: Scatter about one ounce (4-5 bracts) of bait per artichoke plant on bare ground in vole-infested areas. Apply bait near vole burrow openings or runways. Do not overbait! Be careful to scatter bait so that it does not directly contact any part of the artichoke plant. If necessary, make second and third applications at 21-day intervals. Do not exceed three applications in one 12-month period.
