# **CDFA UPDATES**

Mr. Kratville reported a reduction of rodenticide sales. The Committee discussed various factors that may be contributing to the reduction including increased restrictions for applying rodenticides and more requirements for counties that sell rodenticides.

Discussion followed.

Mr. Kratville reported the current status of Assembly Bill 751, which was introduced to reauthorize the VPCRAC legislation set to expire in 2016. Initially the bill was issued with a sunset date of ten years.

Mr. Kratville attended a Fish and Game Commission Meeting reviewing predator management within California. The goal is to review existing policies and regulations to identify and address inconsistencies. The Commission is addressing structural issues first and will later review ethical and ecological concerns.

The Tri Colored Blackbird received emergency protection under the California Endangered Species Act in December 2014. It is a temporary listing of six months but may be extended.

Discussion followed.

Mr. Kratville reported there are no changes regarding the use of gas cartridges. The USDA is currently waiting for a decision on what mitigation measures will be implemented including possible geographical restrictions to protect burrowing endangered species.

Mr. Kratville received a call from Yolo County reporting gopher infestations in drip irrigated alfalfa. The Committee discussed issues that may have caused the increased populations.

Discussion followed.

# A CALIFORNIA SPECIAL LOCAL NEEDS LABEL FOR ZINC PHOSPHIDE ON CABBAGE

Mr. Kratville gave a brief overview of the Special Local Needs Registration Label for Zinc Phosphide Concentrate held by Modoc County. Mr. Joe Moreno with the Modoc County Agricultural Commissioner's Office provided the Committee with copies of the label. The label is only valid in Lassen, Modoc, and Siskiyou Counties for use on alfalfa, pasture, rangeland, non-crop area for control of Belding Ground Squirrels. The only allowed application method is spot treatment by ground. Growers in north eastern California expressed interest and pursued the label. Mr. Moreno is waiting for efficacy data and will provide updates to the Committee. Due to supply issues there were no applications made in California this year.

Discussion followed.
